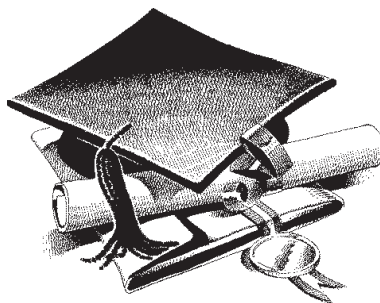

- Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average.
- Applicant must enroll in a College/University by the next Fall Semester and agree to release grades to Teen Graffiti Magazine.
- Applicant must have recommendation section completed and signed. (i.e., teachers, high school counselors, and/or employers)
- Applicant must agree to participate in a community service project coordinated by Teen Graffiti.
- Applicant must submit a typed, double-spaced, two page biographical sketch including:
  - Creative abilities
  - Leadership skills
  - Community Service
  - School Activities
